10th, 11th, and 12th grade students may report to the High School Performing Arts Center any time during the designated two hour block of time. The complete process should take less than an hour, so plan to attend at a time that is most convenient for you. Students new to the district, or students with a new electronic device, need to bring their device to registration.

9th grade students should report to the High School Gymnasium at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, August 25th and remain through the conclusion of Freshman Connection at 12:00 p.m. This event is for students only. Check-In begins at 8:45 a.m. in the Athletic Lobby. Lunch will be provided. 9th grade students must bring their electronic device to registration.
