*The Real ACT Prep Guide* is an official guide produced by ACT with retired test questions. **ACT Practice** questions are available at [www.actstudent.org](http://www.actstudent.org) under Test Prep-practice questions. There are five sets of questions for each subtest – these include answers with explanation to add in the process of taking the test.

**ACT online prep** is official guide to the ACT. Presented in an interactive media format, this web-based program offers practice tests with real ACT test questions; practice essays for the optional ACT Writing Test, with real-time scoring; comprehensive content review for each of the ACT's four required tests—English, Math, Reading, and Science; diagnostic test and study path; anywhere, anytime access via the Internet.
