STUDENT REQUEST FOR MATH PLACEMENT TESTING

(FOR INCOMING 10TH, 11TH, AND 12TH GRADE STUDENTS TESTING INTO THE HONORS MATH SEQUENCE THROUGH MATH PLACEMENT TESTING)

Incoming 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students wishing to move from the regular math sequence to the honors math sequence must have permission of their current math teacher and take a Math Placement Test. Students earning a B+ or higher (87.0% or greater) on the Math Placement Test will be permitted to enroll in the honors math sequence. Taking a math placement test to move into the honors math sequence is different than testing out of a math course in that no credit is earned for demonstrating competency. Students wishing to Test Out of an entire math course, thereby, earning credit for that course, and not moving into the honors math sequence must sign-up for Testing Out, not Math Placement Testing.

If you wish to move into the honors math sequence please complete the information below, secure a signature from your current math teacher indicating approval, and submit this form to the Guidance Office by **Friday, May 8, 2015**. **Forms submitted after this date will NOT be accepted.** **Math Placement Testing will be administered on August 24, 2015 at 9:00 a.m.**
