If you only need one class, or maybe more, MySchool's summer program can help. You may take up to two classes at one time, up to 4 classes during the summer. Enrollment is on-going, but be sure to leave yourself time to complete a class.

Like other MySchool classes, summer school will be delivered mostly online with support from online instructors. You'll also report as needed to one of our community locations for testing. You'll need a laptop or computer with internet access to participate and complete your work – this can be your own or a computer and/or internet at a public location (library, coffee shop, etc.) Cost per class is \$125.00. Payment in full reserves your spot in the program.
