Grades and Report Cards

- **Marking period dates:**

Grades

- Marking periods = checkpoint – a snapshot in time
- MP1 + MP2 + Exam = **Final Semester Grade** which is recorded on your transcript.

Transcript - a record of your semester grades throughout high school. GPA is cumulative

- Calculate using the chart on the next slide

Grade Point Average - GPA

A	4.000	C	2.000
A-	3.668	C-	1.668
B+	3.334	D+	1.334
B	3.000	D	1.000
B-	2.668	D-	0.668
C+	2.334	E	0.000

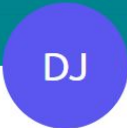
Sample GPA Calculation

- 6 classes per semester
 - English 1 B+ 3.334
 - PE A 4.000
 - Physics B- 2.668
 - Spanish 3 A- 3.668
 - Foundation Art A- 3.668
 - Geometry B ~~3.000~~
- Total grade points 20.338

- $20.338/6$ classes = **3.390 for one semester.**

Each subsequent semester is combined with this to form a cumulative grade point average throughout high school.
