ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF REQUIREMENTS

The following are requirements to earn the IB Diploma:

- Three Standard Level (SL) courses and three Higher Level (HL) courses are required. (There is an option to enroll in 4 HL courses and 2 SL courses, but it is not advised.)
- One subject from each Group 1-5 is required; final subject may be chosen from Group 6.
- A Creativity, Activity, and Service (CAS) experience outside the traditional school day.
- A Theory of Knowledge (TOK) course will be an additional class beyond the traditional six-hour day. Students will earn an additional credit for this course. TOK will be a weighted course.
- An Extended Essay (EE) primarily completed independently and outside the school day. The candidate will have an Extended Essay (EE) advisor.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

In the event an IB DP candidate desires to withdraw from the Diploma Programme, the candidate must meet with their EE Coordinator, the IB Coordinator, and their counselor. The purpose of these meetings is to ensure the candidate is making a sound decision. If the candidate desires to withdraw during the middle of the year, the candidate must remain in his/her IB courses until the end of the year; however, the candidate may withdraw from TOK, EE, and CAS. Once the student withdraws from TOK, EE, and CAS, they may not re-enroll in the IB Diploma Programme.
